**WESTMINSTER LARGER CATECHISM**

Question 193: *What do we pray for in the fourth petition?*

Answer: In the fourth petition—*Give us this day our daily bread*—we acknowledge that in Adam and by our own sin, we have forfeited our right to all the outward blessings of this life, and deserve to be wholly deprived of them by God, and to have them cursed to us in the use of them; and thus we depend upon the providence of God from day to day to provide and sustain us by His free gift.
