**WESTMINSTER LARGER CATECHISM**

Question 194: What do we pray for in the fifth petition?

Answer: In the fifth petition—*forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors*—we acknowledge that we and all others are guilty both of original and actual sin, and thereby become debtors to the justice of God; and that neither we, nor any other creature, can make the least satisfaction for that debt. We pray for ourselves and others, that God of His free grace would, through the obedience and satisfaction of Christ, apprehend and applied by faith what would forgive us from the guilt and punishment of sin.
