**WESTMINSTER CATECHISM**

Question 22: How did Christ, being the Son of God, become man?  
Answer: Christ, the Son of God, became man, by taking to himself a true body, and a reasonable soul, being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the womb of the Virgin Mary, and born of her, yet without sin.  
Scripture: Hebrews 2:14-16; Hebrews 10:5; Matt. 26:38; Luke 1:27-42; Galatians 4:4; Hebrews 4:15; 7:26.

What is the “fullness of the Gentiles?” In our time, God is visiting the Gentiles to take out a people for His Name. God is visiting the Gentile nations, and forming the Bride of Christ. When that is complete, the Lord will come, and the times of the Gentiles will finish (see Luke 21:24). It is at that time that Paul says: “All Israel shall be saved.”

Verses 28-29 summarize Paul's argument. The Jewish nation has become an enemy of the gospel. God will never repent of the promises He made to Abraham.

As Paul finishes with a doxology, he remembers that God's ways cannot be searched out nor can they even be traced. Out of God all things come.
