WESTMINSTER CATECHISM

Question 24: How does Christ execute the office of a prophet?

Answer: Christ executes the office of a prophet, in revealing to us, by His word and Spirit, the will of God for our salvation.

Scripture: John 1:18; I Peter 1:10-12

"Concerning the sacrifice" Romans 12:1-2 (meditation verses)

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Concerning this sacrifice, Paul says three things:

First, he tells us what kind of a sacrifice it should be, and that is a holy sacrifice. We are sinners and we can come only through the merit of His holy blood.

Second, it is acceptable. God will receive it, because it is well pleasing. It is attractive to and excites the pleasure of a holy and loving God.

Third, it is reasonable. "Your reasonable service." Basically the word means logical, in the sense that it is the response of a man who recognizes that he was bought with a price and therefore belongs to the one who bought him. It is reasonable in the sense that it is the response of a moral creature made in the image of God. It is spiritual in the sense that it is the response of a creature who rises to the highest point of priestly service.
