**WESTMINSTER CATECHISM**

Question 26: How does Christ execute the office of a king?

Answer: Christ executes the office of a king, in subduing us to himself, in ruling, and defending us, and in restraining and conquering all his and our enemies.

Scripture: Acts 15:14-16; Isaiah 33:22

Romans 12:1-2: *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*

The Will of God and the Mercies of God"

Romans 12:1-2 deal with the issue of the will of God, and it is described in three aspects:

- (1) Good--that is pure. God's will is always good. It may be hard, but it is always good.
- (2) Acceptable--it ought to be acceptable to you, because it is acceptable to Him!
- (3) Perfect--Sometimes the will of God leads you into places that you cannot see the reasons for, and it seems that everything is going wrong. But remember that His will is perfect. No matter how devious the way may be, His will is perfect because "He knows the end from the beginning."
