“Beyond the Church to the World”

*Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.”*

Verse 17 reaches beyond the church and takes in the outsiders. When a man does evil, do not pay him back that way. The words “good things” refer to that which is honorable or beautiful.

Christians should have regard for what people think about them. We ought to have some regard for the sight of men. We are not to be in bondage to public opinion; yet it is wrong to have the attitude that we will let the chips fall where they may. Rather, think of those things that are beautiful, and then there will be no reproach upon the church of God.

Verse 18 confronts believers with a most difficult task, and only by the grace of God can we do it. Paul admonishes us to live at peace with one another. This does not mean peace at the expense of righteousness, but the point is this: you are never to be the one to break the peace. We are not to give in to everything that comes. When it concerns me individually, then it is right for me to give, give to the last drop, and never break the peace.
