We have the key in verse one with the words "higher powers." Verse 8 proposes another idea that no man owes anything except to love one another. Verse 11 points to the day of the Lord's coming which should always be in mind.

There is a threefold outline:

1. The Christian's duty to the state (vv. 1-7)
2. The Christian's duty to the citizens of the state (vv. 8-10)
3. The Christian's duty in view of the near approach of the coming of the Lord (vv. 11-14)

The duty of the Christian to the state is subjection; his duty to citizens of the state is love, and his duty in view of the closeness of Christ's coming is wakefulness.
