In verse 8 we were to owe no man anything. It is true that you should never assume an obligation that you cannot reasonably be sure you can pay in time. There is one debt that you can never pay, and that is the debt of love. The more you pay that debt, the more you owe. The principle of love is portrayed in verse 9—not committing adultery, killing, stealing, coveting. If the state orders you to do those things, you have a right to refuse. Notice that Paul here mentions only those commandments that deal with our relationship with our fellow man, and not God. The state does not have to do with our relation to God, but it has everything to do with our relationship with fellow citizens in the state.

Verse 10 defines more clearly whom we should love. It is the neighbor in the state, anyone who exists along with us as citizens of the state.
