"Final Message to the Weak"

Romans 14:23

*But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.*

Basically, when the weak brother violates his conscience, he sins.

Paul explains this by saying that our thoughts and actions that are not from faith allow our conscience to condemn us.

Three lessons can be drawn from this chapter: The first is a lesson for the strong. Do not despise the weaker brother. The second is for those who are weak: Don't judge your brother if he takes more liberty than you on matters indifferent to the faith.

The third is for both the weak and the strong. The supreme teaching of this chapter is that the voice of conscience must not be ignored. Is the Word of God above the conscience? Yes, of course. But if a weak brother violates his conscience he has started upon a road that can theoretically wreck his whole moral universe. He needs to be taken kindly and patiently to the Word of God and have his conscience corrected.

We ought to live our lives in light of the Lordship of Christ. We ought to live our lives in the light of the judgment seat of Christ. And, we ought to live our lives in the light of the cross of Christ. Remember the admonition: "Destroy not your brother for whom Christ died." Sobering thoughts for all of us.
