"Introduction to Chapter 15"

This chapter is closely connected with the previous one. Those who are strong should bear the infirmities of those who are weak and not please themselves. We should each please his neighbor. Paul holds up Christ as an example of One who did not please Himself. A key word is ministry. In the eighth verse Jesus Christ was a minister, and in verse 16 we are to be ministers of Jesus Christ. It is found again in verse 25 and verse 31. For an outline, we will see the Ministration of Jesus Christ in verses 1-13. Jesus' ministry was sacrificial (vv. 1-7), and the ministry was impartial (vv. 8-13).

Then, the Ministration of the Apostle Paul in verses 14-32. There are four aspects to Paul's ministry: it was personal (vv. 14-17); it was powerful (vv. 18-21), it was purposeful (vv. 22-29); and it was prayerful (vv. 30-33). I anticipate a great blessing as we look through this 15th chapter.
