Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and gave Himself for it.

The case of the Greek noun "wives" is such that it is really "the wives" meaning that all wives are to follow this instruction. The same is true of "the husbands" and the rest. Wives in this case are to subordinate themselves to their husbands in a manner becoming their position as wives. To state that man is the head of the woman, the Apostle Paul was just reaffirming what was accepted and recognized. Paul like Peter in I Peter 3:7 gives instruction about the conduct of wives. Paul illustrates the relationship of husband as head of the wife by using Christ and his relationship to the church. Christ has the best interest of the church at heart, and so the thought is that the husband should have the best interest of the wife at heart. Out of love and respect for that kind of love, the church in verse 24 subjects itself to Christ, and so should the wives subject themselves to the husband in like manner. Basically, this passage is saying that husbands must keep on loving their wives, or "make a habit of" loving your wives. The love of the husband for the wife is to be the continuous abiding habitual emotion, and it is not to be interrupted by things or emotions. The verb for love is the same as that used of the love of God--agapao in Greek. God put such value on mankind that even when we were hopelessly bound by sin, God gave His Son as the price of redemption. That is sacrificial love.

That needs to be said in order to understand Paul's admonition to husbands to love their wives as Christ loves the church. How did Christ love the Church? He gave up His own welfare and interests and totally sacrificed them in order to provide redemption for the Church.

If husbands showed that agape love as Christ demonstrated, then the wives would have no trouble keeping the demands of verses 22-24.
