Ephesians 6:21-24

<sup>21</sup> But that you also may know my affairs and how I am doing, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make all things known to you; <sup>22</sup> whom I have sent to you for this very purpose, that you may know our affairs, and that he may comfort your hearts.

<sup>23</sup> Peace to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>24</sup> Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.

Paul assured the readers that Tychicus would inform them of all his affairs and would comfort them with the assurance that even though Paul was a prisoner all was well with him.

The letter of the Ephesians closes with the same wish of grace and peace that had opened the letter. Peace is joined to love and faith as a blessing that Paul pronounced upon his Christian brethren. This peace, love, and faith had their source in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. The blessing of grace, God's own favor, is extended to all those who love the Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love. How thankful we can be that Paul wrote this letter to the Ephesians, and in it gave us the great picture of the Church as the Bride of Christ. May God bless you every time you read His Word.
