“The Story of the Great Fish”

Jonah’s experience with the great fish in Jonah 1:17 was certainly a miracle. I have read of a few individuals that have survived being swallowed by a whale. The miracle is that it was God’s divine appointment that the great fish was there at the moment that Jonah was thrown overboard. It was God’s way of allowing one of His creatures to deal with a disobedient prophet.

All miracles are beyond human comprehension. Only faith in God can satisfy the natural question of how this took place, and how Jonah was released after three days. It is always a matter of faith. One thing for sure is that the bodies of those who have survived were burned by the stomach acids of the large fish. Jonah would have had that as well, and perhaps when he told his story in Ninevah, it was easy for the people to believe that what he was saying was true. The evidence of his complexion was a tangible proof of what he was saying.
