Veteran's Day is a reminder to all of us that the privileges that we have in this land were at a price—the time and in many cases the very lives of young men and women. They gave their best, and it is now up to us to be vigilant to defend that freedom and to enjoy the benefits of that freedom. It is the same with our eternal salvation that cost Christ Jesus His life. Now we are to defend our faith in Christ and to enjoy the benefits of our salvation right now. Sunday is the Lord's Day. One of the greatest benefits is to worship the Savior—to be with Christ.

"Survey and Outline of Jonah"

The book of Jonah in chapters 1 and 2 focuses on the prophet himself and we see the power of God to do as He sees fit. Jonah is commissioned to go to Ninevah and save the city from destruction. He disobeys and runs the other way--to the end of the Great Sea in Spain.

Chapters 3-4 focus on the mission that Jonah is to execute in Ninevah, and we see the mercy of God as He forgives. Jonah receives the Commission again "Arise, go to Nineveh." This time he does what God desires and he saves Nineveh, that Great City.

God and His relationship to Jonah are highlighted in each chapter:

God commissions Jonah in chapter 1

God Hears Jonah's prayer of repentance in chapter 2

God spares Nineveh as Jonah preaches revival in that great city

God reproves Jonah for his short-cited ministry vision in chapter 4.
