“BY MANY INFALLABLE PROOFS”

Dear Family of Bible Fellowship:

At this Easter season, we are reminded of the focus of our church – to bring everyone into a personal relationship with Christ as both their Savior and their Lord. This focus and indeed our entire Christian faith hinges upon Christ's Cross and His triumphant Resurrection. It is the only sure foundation that yields forgiveness of sin, enjoyment of the abundant Christian life, and the full assurance of our heavenly home.

The Resurrection reminds us of the victory of Christ on the Cross, while the Cross itself reminds us of the work that He accomplished in His life on our behalf. Christ came to fulfill the plan from all eternity as the Lamb slain before the foundation of the world (Revelation 13:8). His teachings and His sacrificial death both remind us that Christ never stepped away from the Father's Will. When he said, “It is finished,” Christ saw the plan of redemption complete.

It is our duty then to follow the precept found in Romans 12:1 – *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.* Our task as believers is to grow daily in our knowledge of Christ and the Bible. As we do so, our lives will be transformed into exactly what God planned for us. If you do not sense a growth in your relationship with Christ, then let the messages of this Easter season be a time of rededication to truly grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior.
