### Prayer and Thanksgiving for the LORD's Righteous Judgments

To the Chief Musician. To *the tune of* "Death of the Son." A Psalm of David.

**9** I will praise *You*, O LORD, with my whole heart;

I will tell of all Your marvelous works.

**2** **I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.**

**3** When my enemies turn back, They shall fall and perish at Your presence.

**4** **For You have maintained my right and my cause;**

**You sat on the throne judging in righteousness.**

**5** You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the wicked;

You have blotted out their name forever and ever.

**6** **O enemy, destructions are finished forever! And you have destroyed cities;**

**Even their memory has perished.**

**7** But the LORD shall endure forever; He has prepared His throne for judgment.

**8** **He shall judge the world in righteousness,**

**And He shall administer judgment for the peoples in uprightness.**

**9** The LORD also will be a refuge<sup>[c]</sup> for the oppressed, A refuge in times of trouble.

**10** **And those who know Your name will put their trust in You;**

**For You, LORD, have not forsaken those who seek You.**

**11** Sing praises to the LORD, who dwells in Zion!

Declare His deeds among the people.

**12** **When He avenges blood, He remembers them;**

**He does not forget the cry of the humble.**

**13** Have mercy on me, O LORD! Consider my trouble from those who hate me,

You who lift me up from the gates of death,

**14** **That I may tell of all Your praise In the gates of <sup>[c]</sup>the daughter of Zion.**

**I will rejoice in Your salvation.**

**15** The nations have sunk down in the pit *which* they made;

In the net which they hid, their own foot is caught.

**16** **The LORD is known *by* the judgment He executes;**

**The wicked is snared in the work of his own hands.**

**17** The wicked shall be turned into hell, *And* all the nations that forget God.

**18** **For the needy shall not always be forgotten;**

**The expectation of the poor shall *not* perish forever.**

**19** Arise, O LORD, Do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged in Your sight.

**20** **Put them in fear, O LORD, *That* the nations may know themselves *to be but* men. *Selah***
