But You brought us out to rich fulfillment.

¹³ I will go into Your house with burnt offerings; I will pay You my vows,

¹⁴ **Which my lips have uttered And my mouth has spoken when I was in trouble.**

¹⁵ I will offer You burnt sacrifices of fat animals,

With the sweet aroma of rams; I will offer bulls with goats. *Selah*

¹⁶ **Come and hear, all you who fear God,**

And I will declare what He has done for my soul.

¹⁷ I cried to Him with my mouth, And He was extolled with my tongue.

¹⁸ **If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear.**

¹⁹ *But* certainly God has heard *me*; He has attended to the voice of my prayer.

²⁰ Blessed *be* God, Who has not turned away my prayer, Nor His mercy from me!

He prayed for strength that he might achieve;

He was made weak that he might obey.

He prayed for help that he might do great things;

He was given infirmity that he might do better things.

He prayed for riches that he might be happy;

He was given poverty that he might be wise.

He prayed for power that he might have the praise of people;

He was given life that he might enjoy all things.
