The Perfect Revelation of the LORD

To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.

19 The heavens declare the glory of God;

⁴ **Their line has gone out through all the earth,**

The testimony of the LORD *is* sure, making wise the simple;

⁸ **The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;**

The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;

⁹ The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring forever;

The judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.

¹⁰ **More to be desired are they than gold,**

Yea, than much fine gold;

Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

¹¹ Moreover by them Your servant is warned,
